The Combi Pro's dual chains pull the back door forward evenly preventing twisting and eliminating the need for a hydraulic ram. The floor has been designed with no central floor gap that ram-driven systems have, which means less feed loss, product build-up and maintenance.

This helps to reduce waste, save time, and improve on-farm efficiency and cost-effectiveness. It's a real game changer, especially in snowy or muddy conditions.
